
**PROJET EAP - SCOLARISATION
BILAN 2017**

Alouette Foundation est d'avis que l'éducation est un droit humain fondamental. C'est essentiel pour un développement social et économique durable. Ayant ceci à l'esprit, Alouette Foundation a fait tout ce qui est possible depuis 25 ans pour assurer cela pour tous, et surtout pour les pauvres.

Le facteur d'abandon scolaire chez les élèves à tous les niveaux est causé par la pauvreté. Aller à l'école devient plus cher chaque année. Avec l'augmentation du coût de l'éducation, en particulier pour les études universitaires, de plus en plus d'élèves ne peuvent plus aller à l'école ou bien abandonnent les études et ne parviennent pas à obtenir un diplôme.

Reconnaissant ce défi pour les enfants de familles à faibles revenus, Alouette Foundation, en partenariat avec la Fondation Groupe RATP, a élaboré un projet qui vise à fournir une assistance éducative et d'autres aides non matérielles par le biais de formations de compétences de vie, de séances d'apprentissage et autres, telles que des activités psycho-dynamiques pour des élèves issus de familles indigentes à Malibay, Pasay City.

Le projet d'aide à l'éducation (EAP) en partenariat avec la RATP a été officiellement lancé au début de l'année scolaire 2017-2018.



148 élèves ont reçu une aide matérielle leur permettant de s'inscrire et d'assister à leurs cours dès la rentrée scolaire, le 5 juin 2017. Parmi les 148 élèves, 89 sont en écoles élémentaires, 36 en collèges, 2 dans les lycées et 21 sont à l'université.

En plus des fournitures scolaires, des sacs, des uniformes et du paiement des frais de scolarité et frais divers, les élèves ont été également bénéficié de formations diverses et autres activités. Leurs parents ont également bénéficié de formations et autres activités.

Une visite et une inspection des établissements scolaires a également été effectuée par le personnel en charge, en plus des visites aux familles des bénéficiaires.

Les élèves continueront d'avoir une activité mensuelle, tandis que les parents ont des activités une fois par trimestre.

A venir, célébration du mois des enfants courant novembre et une fête de Noël en décembre est prévue pour accueillir tous les bénéficiaires et leurs parents pour le partage, l'apprentissage et pour le plaisir.
